-Wheeler moved, Everett seconded to authorize the Mayor to sign the Professional Services Agreement with David Arthur Consultants, Inc. to provide a Preliminary Architectural Feasibility Report with a Preliminary Floor Plan as well as the necessary documents and requirements for the preliminary submission for pre-approval to the USDA Rural Development for grant and/or loan funding.

-Everett moved, Matthews seconded to appoint Luetta Richards to the Board of Review to fill the remainder of the term that expires December 31, 2019. Carried (4-0)

-Donihue moved, Wheeler seconded to approve a quote from JD Construction to crush pile of asphalt estimated to be between 400-450 ton in the amount of \$8400.

The asphalt was removed from Chestnut Street during the reconstruction in 2015 and grinding the remaining asphalt down to a finer material will make it more conducive to use on road shoulders and city owned gravel lots.
